Case 2 – 25 year old male – severe AR, mildly dilated LV with normal function and CPET, asc Ao 4.0cm

Case 3 – 42 yr old female 11 year old 21mm Perimount, moderate stenosis- wants IVF and pregnancy

Case 4 - 35 yr old female – previous AV repair x2, then tissue AVR now severely stenosed

Case 5 – 30 year old Marfan syndrome aortic root 4.2cm, family history of aortic dissection

Case 6 – 40 yr old aortic root aneurysm 5.2cm, trileaflet valve and genetic testing negative
